According to the Consolidated Appropriations Act, the most recent COVID relief act that includes the PPP funding, banks can begin taking applications tomorrow, January 6th. The Small Business Administration (SBA) hasn't released any of the lending rules yet. We have heard that the interim rules will be released this afternoon and then possibly followed by several addendums and clarifications to follow.

It is imperative that you reach out to your lender now to inquire about this next round of PPP funding as there may be different requirements based on the previous PPP or whether you are a first time applicant.

For California Tenants: COVID-19 Relief Grant Program Deadline Extended

The grant program is offering grants of \$5,000 to \$25,000 for California Small Businesses and Nonprofits, depending on their annual revenue. Due to high demand for the first round of funding, the deadline to apply has been extended to next Wednesday, January 13th. This grant is not first come, first served. All grants submitted by January 13th will be considered for the first funding round.
