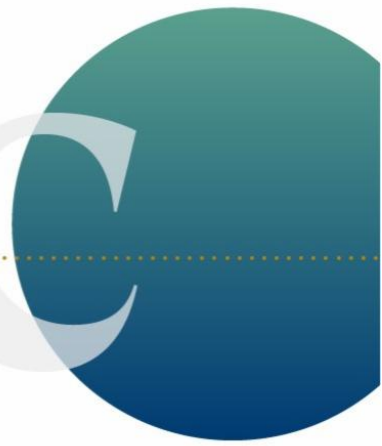

Dear Merchant,

CA Tier Update May 7th – Los Angeles County was granted movement to the less restrictive Yellow Tier on Tuesday, May 4th. Although, the county has met the state qualifications to move in the Yellow tier, a revised [Los Angeles County Health Officer Order](#) went into effect on Thursday, May 6th, to reflect newly permitted activities.

The revised LA County Health Officer Order allows for expanded operations including:

- 75% capacity for grocery & retail store
- 75% capacity for hair salons, barbershops and personal care businesses
- 50% capacity for restaurants
- 50% capacity for fitness centers
- 50% capacity for movie theatres with additional guidelines
- TV's allowed to be turned on both indoors and outdoors
- Outdoor live entertainment at restaurants, bars and breweries

There are two cities Long Beach and Pasadena, with their own Health Departments that revised and enacted eased yellow-tier operations that align with the state guidelines.
